

VEHICLE ENTRY INFORMATION & PROCEDURES

Exhibitors who intend to display a vehicle within the confines of their booth (peninsula & island configurations only) must obtain a vehicle display permit from the Clark County Fire Marshall. The application for Permit can be found on the Online Exhibitor Guide under Rules & Regulations/Show Policies.

Vehicles on display must have fuel filler caps locked or sealed to prevent escape of vapors and to avoid tampering. Vehicles shall not be fueled or refueled within the building. Fuel in the tank shall not exceed ¼ of the tank capacity or 5 gallons, whichever is less. Batteries must be disconnected. Auxiliary batteries not connected to engine starting system may be left connected. No leaks underneath vehicles. At least 36" clear access or aisles must be maintained around the vehicle. Vehicles must be a minimum 20' from exit of door or exit pathway. External chargers are recommended for demonstration purposes.

Failure to Notify Event Management and/or apply for permit no later than three (3) weeks prior to move-in could result in higher permit fees or non-admission of the item/service to the exhibit floor.
